Quoting from the Executive Summary: "After a full inspection, it was observed that because of continuing maintenance agreements carried for the building, systems and the diligence of the Pastoral staff, the Parish facilities, overall, are in good shape." The report noted the two major capital projects that we are undertaking this year, the new roof (completed) and the parking lot re-seal and re-striping.
