Michael McBride who is the national leader for PICO clergy. We are blessed to have him and look forward to an active year for Social Justice efforts.

VOTE NEXT TUESDAY: We have already had the Candidates Forum (see last bulletin) initiated by CCISCO, the Interfaith Council and the Interfaith Movement for Human Integrity, and hope that everyone has read the information about the candidates for Supervisor and will VOTE this Tuesday. Night Walk Against Violence will take place on Friday, June 10 at 7:00 pm at Sycamore and L Streets.

Education Parent trainings: There are continual meetings for parents and those interested in improving our school system and being an advocate for our children. Currently the enrollment rate is declining which means less money from the state. There has also been tremendous turnover for the School board (2 members stepping down in four months) and no permanent Superintendent. There are also a number of lawsuits filed on various issues. **Saturday, August 27, 2016**

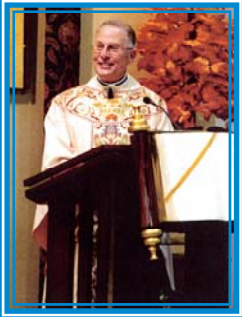
