Walk-up Holy Communion: Sunday 10:30 - 11:30 am.

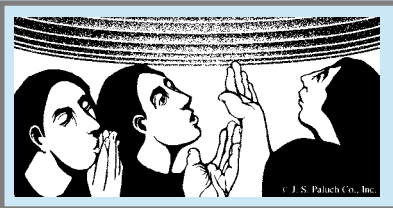

### Flocknote

Sign-up is totally voluntary and easy. Just follow the simple instructions below:

2. Click on "FLOCKNOTE SIGNUP" under Quick Links in the right margin.
3. You will automatically be redirected to the parish's sign-up page at Flocknote.

### San Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila & Companion Martyrs

Lorenzo Ruiz is the first Filipino saint officially declared a martyr for Christianity. He and his companion martyrs were beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1981 and canonized in 1987 in Rome. The Feast Day is September 28th.

Lorenzo Ruiz was born in Manila, Philippines and was educated in a school run by the Dominicans. He served as altar server, "escribiente" of the confraternity of the Rosary. He was a family man, and an adverse event made him leave the Philippines, joining the Dominican mission to Japan where later he and his companions were arrested, tortured and executed in Okinawa for their Christian faith.

### Sunday Liturgy Participation

Our in-person Liturgies on Sunday mornings at 9AM are going very well. Thank you to everyone who help to make them so successful!

We will begin with one Liturgy every Sunday at 9AM. Seating is limited, so it is important to make your reservation using the Flocknote link on the church's website and Facebook page.

*We will be offering walk-up Holy Communion at the front doors of the church and drive thru for those who are disabled and choose not to attend in-person worship. However, due to the warmer weather we have and will experience, the times of Holy Communion will be from 10:30AM-11:30AM every Sunday.*

We kindly ask that if you choose to participate in receiving Holy Communion as explained above, **do not** arrive before 10:30AM. This will allow a smooth transition for those attending in-person worship to leave the parking lot after Liturgy, and create a safe environment in the parking lot for all those involved.

*Liturgy will continue to be available for viewing "on line" as we do now for those Parishioners choosing to watch at home.*

*There is a short video available that we encourage everyone to watch regarding in-person worship in the lawn area. In the video, all the procedures will be provided, that way you will know what to expect when you make your reservation, arrive for Liturgy, and process from the lawn area to receive Holy Communion as you leave.*
