Flocknote

Don't forget to sign-up for Flocknote to receive emails from St. Ignatius of Antioch parish.

Sign-up is totally voluntary and easy. Just follow the simple instructions below:

1. Go to the parish website: www.st.ignatiusofantioch.org
2. Click on "FLOCKNOTE SIGNUP" under Quick Links in the right margin.
3. You will automatically be redirected to the parish's sign-up page at Flocknote.
4. Enter your name, email address and **mobile** phone number (entering your mobile phone is optional) and click the Sign Me Up button.
5. You will receive an email from Flocknote to verify your email address. Just click on the **Verify my email button** and you're done!

Sunday Liturgy Participation

Our in-person Liturgies on Sunday mornings at 9AM are going very well. Thank you to everyone who help to make them so successful!

We will begin with one Liturgy every Sunday at 9AM. Seating is limited, so it is important to make your reservation using the Flocknote link on the church's website and Facebook page.

We will be offering walk-up Holy Communion at the front doors of the church and drive thru for those who are disabled and choose not to attend in-person worship. However, due to the warmer weather we have and will experience, the times of Holy Communion will be from 10:30AM-11:30AM every Sunday.

We kindly ask that if you choose to participate in receiving Holy Communion as explained above, **do not** arrive before 10:30AM. This will allow a smooth transition for those attending in-person worship to leave the parking lot after Liturgy, and create a safe environment in the parking lot for all those involved.

Liturgy will continue to be available for viewing "on line" as we do now for those Parishioners choosing to watch at home.

There is a short video available that we encourage everyone to watch regarding in-person worship in the lawn area. In the video, all the procedures will be provided, that way you will know what to expect when you make your reservation, arrive for Liturgy, and process from the lawn area to receive Holy Communion as you leave.

Most important, we want to welcome everyone back for in-person Worship!

St. Vincent de Paul Thanksgiving Outreach

The St. Vincent de Paul Thanksgiving distribution for 2020 is going virtual! The distribution will be a drive through only event in our parking lot and participants will receive a turkey and a food gift card – no baskets. Monetary donations will be accepted through Sunday, November 22nd. **If you or someone you know would like to receive a turkey and food gift card as part of this outreach, reservations are required.** Call 757-7450 (English) or 757-0941 (Español) on Monday, November 2 or Tuesday, November 3 from 9:00am – noon and 1:00pm to 4:00pm on both days. Reservations will be taken only at these numbers and there is a limit of 150 reservations. If the lines are busy, keep trying. You must speak to a representative in order to make a reservation. Antioch residency is required.

Fresh Fruits & Vegetables

As of this writing, the Food Bank is continuing with their community distribution of fresh fruits and vegetables. This free service is available for low-income families.

Distribution at St. Ignatius of Antioch is scheduled for the 1st and 3rd Fridays of every month from 3:30 to 4:30 pm in the church parking lot.
