Walk-up Holy Communion: Sunday 10:30 - 11:30 am.



## Weekend Liturgies

In-person liturgies are offered each Saturday morning at 9am (indoors) and each Sunday morning at 9am (outdoors). We are grateful to all of the volunteers who have stepped forward to make these liturgies possible. More volunteers are needed, especially as we move into the holiday season. If you can help, please call the parish office and leave your contact information.

### In-person Liturgy Reminders:

- Seating is limited and reservations are required.
- Make your reservation by responding to the Flocknote email which is sent the Monday morning before the weekend liturgies. For those of you without access to a smart phone or a computer to receive emails, a limited number of slots are reserved for call in reservations. Make sure you speak with a staff member. Do not leave a voicemail message.
- Please do not attend if you are not feeling well.
- Face coverings are mandatory.
- Practice social distancing in the parking lot and when walking to and from the liturgy. Bring your own hand-sanitizer if possible.
- Plan on arriving 30 minutes before the liturgy starts.
- Parking lot gates are closed 10 minutes before the start of each liturgy.
- If attending the outdoor liturgy, bring your own lawn chair.

### Walk up Holy Communion Reminders:

- Available every Sunday from 10:30am until 11:30am at the front doors of the church. Drive thru is available for those who are unable to walk.
- Important: please do not arrive before 10:30 to allow the in-person liturgy attendees to exit the parking lot.
