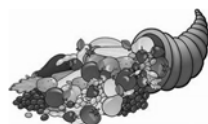

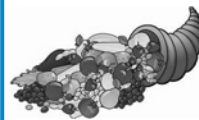
Sunday liturgy is still available for viewing on YouTube.

In-person Liturgy Reminders:

- Seating is limited and reservations are required.
- Make your reservation by responding to the Flocknote email which is sent the Monday morning before the weekend liturgies. For those of you without access to a smart phone or a computer to receive emails, a limited number of slots are reserved for call-in reservations. Make sure you speak with a staff member. Do not leave a voicemail message.
- Please do not attend if you are not feeling well.
- Face coverings are mandatory.
- Practice social distancing in the parking lot and when walking to and from the liturgy. Bring your own hand-sanitizer if possible.
- Plan on arriving 30 minutes before the liturgy starts.
- Parking lot gates are closed 10 minutes before the start of each liturgy.
- If attending the outdoor liturgy, bring your own lawn chair (only during the summer months).

Walk up Holy Communion Reminders:

- Available every Sunday from 10:30am until 11:30am at the front doors of the church. Drive thru is available for those who are unable to walk.
- Important: please do not arrive before 10:30 to allow the in-person liturgy attendees to exit the parking lot.
